By 2000, Fairview had outgrown its original Cheltenham site and so that was sold for the company to concentrate on growing and developing the Honeybourne base.

They have recently undergone a complete refurbishment which includes a new DIY store which has given the opportunity to introduce new lines including tools for every occasion and comprehensive ranges for plumbers and electricians.

"Our greatest challenge has always been to stock the right products, remain competitive without compromising quality, and give customers a service that is second to none," says Stuart.

"And thanks to our massive stocks of building materials we are confident that, assisted by our very knowledgeable and friendly staff, they will find the right building supplies at the right price."
